Sydney Metro City & Southwest Chatswood to Sydenham (SSI 15_7400): Approval of the Sydenham Station & Junction Construction Environmental Management Plan and sub-plans

I refer to your submission of the Construction Environmental Management Plan (CEMP) and supporting sub-plans, including two monitoring programs for the Sydenham Station & Junction works (SSJ) stage of the project, under Conditions C8 and C13. I also note further revisions to these documents, responding to the Department’s detailed comments and requirements.

The Department has reviewed the supporting information and updated documents, and considers that they satisfactorily address the requirements of the relevant conditions.

On this basis, in accordance with Conditions C8 and C13, I approve the following documents in **Table 1**.

Table 1. Management plan/ sub-plan/ monitoring program for approval

I note there are other requirements that must be implemented to meet your obligations under the approval, including (but not limited to):

- Condition E21 - The Heritage Interpretation Plan (noted at Section 7.9 of the Heritage sub plan) must be submitted to the Department for information prior to the commencement of SSJ construction.
- Conditions E24 – excavation and/or salvage works must be undertaken by a qualified archaeologist in consultation with the Registered Aboriginal Parties.
- Condition E25 – if previously unidentified Aboriginal objects are discovered during construction, then the requirements of the condition must be met.
- Conditions E28, E29, E30 and E31 and REMM NV3 – the requirements must be met to ensure vibration impacts are avoided.
- Out of Hours Works – the requirements of the relevant EPL, or the approved Out of Hours Works Protocol (Revision 1.3, dated 4 July 2017) must be met (if an EPL is not in place).

Please ensure you make the documents listed in Table 1 available on the project website, as soon as possible. This requirement also includes other associated documents required under the terms of the project approval, including the Construction Noise and Vibration Impact Statements.

You are also reminded that if there is any inconsistency between the approved plans and the conditions of the approval, then the requirements of the conditions of approval will prevail.
